Friday 9th and Saturday 10th November

Friday 9th November

Meet at Levisham station (YO18 7NN) 9.30am.

If coming from the south take the A169 from Pickering and drive to the Lockton and Levisham turn off. There is a valley between the two villages. Once in the village in sight of the Horseshoe pub look for a sign to the left. This takes you down a windy road to the station. Park in the station car park. FTR checks to do.

The station tea hut at Levisham will be open for sandwiches and snacks both days. Toilets will be unlocked for us at Levisham and Trout Farm near Pickering (YO18 8JJ). The gradients are between 1/179 and 1/332 for the 5 miles journey. I haven't arranged to go beyond Carriage and Wagon into Pickering station, they often shunt. We could walk into town for tea at Bothams.

The machines can stay at Levisham overnight.

Saturday 10th November

Meet at Levisham station car park (YO18 7NN) 9.30am

Travel through to Goathland station (YO22 5NF), approximately 8 1/2 miles, with gradients of between 1/49 and 1/1038.

The tea hut at Levisham will be open for snacks and hot drinks. I need to confirm that Goathland tearoom will be open. We need to return around 2pm, daylight is against us but the gradient is in our favour.

Levisham car park will take around 20 cars and loos are available at both Goathland and Levisham.

Saturday evening

Awards ceremony but possibly not a film show alongside pie and mash supper (£6) in the Crossing Club, Grosmont. Should be open from 6.30, meal at 7pm.

Friday we could possibly meet for a bar meal somewhere, the Bottom Horseshoe at Egton Bridge is scrummy but may be changing hands.
